




Welcome to the dual enrollment program at Joliet Junior College! Joliet provides a convenient online registration process using DualEnroll.com. Here's how to register for your course(s).

# First Time Students - Create an Account


You can register by computer or right on your smart phone by entering <u>https://jjc.dualenroll.com/login</u> and clicking on **CREATE MY ACCOUNT**.

Complete the **New Student Registration** form to create your account. Provide all information including a login name and password. All fields marked with a red asterisk (\*) are required. You must provide either an email account or cell phone number to create the account. If a cell phone is used, standard text message rates apply.

Once you click **CREATE ACCOUNT**, you'll receive either a text message with an activation code or an email with a link to confirm your account. You <u>must</u> confirm your account before you can proceed with the registration. *If using email, be sure to check your junk and spam folders for the email.* Log back into your DualEnroll account and complete the following steps.




